

SJRGC Archery Group 2024 Summary

2024 was another busy year for our archery group. Our overall attendance was the same as the previous year for both our indoor and outdoor seasons. Below is a summary of our year in 2024 and our plans for this coming year:

2024 Summary:

- We continued our weekly Monday outdoor 3D shoots this past season, starting in late May and shooting until early September.
- Shooter participation at our Monday evening shoots was about the same as the previous year with an average of 10 shooters per night.
- Our second indoor season at Queen Elizabeth High went very well, and we added several new shooters to our group.
- Our group participated in the Archery Canada National Indoor Mailmatch tournament in 2024, with a couple of our shooters receiving medals in their respective classes.
- Our target stands we repaired or replaced for our 2024/2025 indoor season.

2025 Plans:

- We were fortunate to secure our indoor facility again for this year. This has been a great location for our group, and we hope to continue shooting here for years to come.
- Our club is renewing its membership with Archery Canada again for 2025, which will allow several of our archers to participate in the National weekly Mailmatch archery tournament again this year.
- Our 3D trail will require routine spring maintenance during our cleanup day, but no major work will need to be done this year.
- Several of our target butts are starting to wear out and we may look at replacing a couple of them later in 2025. Our 3D targets are good and should not require any replacements this year.
