2025 was another busy year for our archery group. Our overall attendance was the same as 2024 for both our outdoor and indoor seasons. Below is a summary of our year in 2025 as well as our plans for this coming year.

2025 Summary:

- We continued our weekly Monday outdoor 3D shoots, starting in May and continuing into September.
- Shooter participation on Monday evenings averaged 6-8 shooters per night.
- Our indoor season at Queen Elizabeth Regional High School went very well, and we continue to get new shooters to the group.

2026 Plans:

- We continue to receive support from Queen Elizabeth High for indoor archery again this year. This is a great location for our group, and we hope to continue shooting here in the years to come.
- Our club has renewed its membership with Archery Canada, with several members participating in the National Weekly Indoor Archery Mail Match tournament.

- Three new lanes were added to our 3D course last year.
- Our target butts are experiencing a lot of wear and tear, and several of them will need to be replaced over the next year. Our 3D targets remain in good shape and will not need to be replaced this year.
