GENERAL INFORMATION

This shoot is sanctioned by the Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA) and the Atlantic Provinces Trapshooting Association (APTA). ATA rules will govern shooting in all events.

Shoot Management insists on safe gun handling at all times. Shooters who enter the competition agree to abide by the ATA and St. John's Rod and Gun Club safety rules. Violators subject themselves to disqualification, without recourse, and may be required to leave the grounds.

Shoot Management reserves the right to reject any entry or change the program as conditions warrant. Shoot Management also reserves the right to disqualify, or refuse entry to anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of the shoot in any manner.

Payment will be by cash or cheque made payable to the St. John's Rod and Gun Club. There will be no refunds on targets, trophies or options unless an event is cancelled.

Please show courtesy to other shooters by refraining from loud or boisterous conduct while behind shooters still competing on the firing line, especially during the handicap events. Your cooperation is appreciated.

REGISTRATION

The registration desk will open at 2 PM on Friday, July 12 and at 8 AM on all other event days. Shoot Management asks that shooters familiarize themselves with all shoot entry fees and purses. This will avoid unnecessary registration delays.

CLASSIFICATION AND HANDICAPPING

Classification will be determined by current target year average and known ability. Known ability will consider official shooting averages, non registered scores and any other information determining a shooter's ability. All shooters are requested to have their ATA Average Card up to date before presenting to the Classification Committee for classification. Up to date Average Cards printed from the ATA's Shooter Information Center will be accepted for classification.

SPECIAL CATEGORY DECLARATION

It is the responsibility of special category shooters to ensure that their special category has been noted on their entry form prior to cashiering for the first event entered. Once Category declarations have been made by the shooter or shoot management, the declaration is final and cannot be changed. There shall be no exception to this rule.

SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY

Each shooter is responsible for checking their score as posted and to make sure their money options are indicated properly. No score will be changed once the Purse or Option monies have been posted.

Due to the number of shooters expected, and in an effort to complete the events in a timely manner, shooters are requested to be at the shooting line promptly and prepared to shoot after the previous squad finishes shooting. Shoot Management also asks that squads move through events without any unnecessary delays or breaks. Your cooperation is appreciated.

TARGET SETTING / TARGETS

The Target Setting Committee will set targets each morning and for event changes. Targets will be set in accordance with ATA rules and shall be only reset only if they vary from ATA standards. The final decision whether or not a trap is to be reset shall be made by a member of the Target Setting Committee.

Purse Rules

1. Open to all ATA members registering ATA targets in the Atlantic Provinces
2. Shooters must register 1000 targets from August 31, 2018 to September 1, 2019
3. Only targets registered in the Atlantic Provinces qualify for purse requirements
4. Winner must attend the 2019 and 2020 Atlantic Provinces shoots to claim prize
5. Purse is non transferable
6. Purse includes target fees for the Atlantic Provinces Championship Events 4 to 6
7. Shooter Daily Fees and all other Purse Options are the responsibility of the shooter
8. Draw will take place September 1 at the 2019 Atlantic Provinces Championships

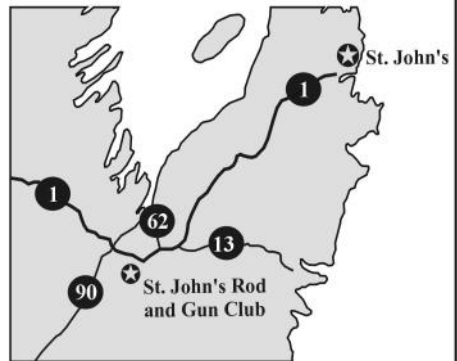
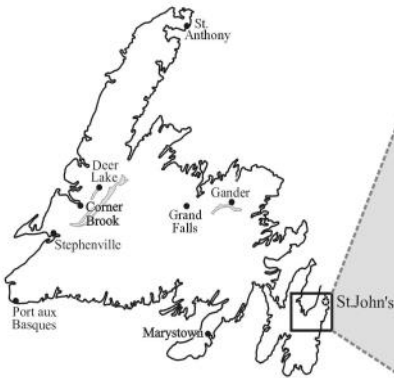
